November 1 Arrive Kilimanjaro airport (JRO) where you will be met by a Maniago guide and transfer to **Arusha Coffee Lodge Meals on Plane**

November 6 Today you will drive to the bottom of the crater. The Ngorongoro Crater is one of the most breathtaking natural wonders in Africa. It is the world's largest inactive, intact, and unfilled volcanic caldera. Formed around two to three million years ago. The crater was created when a massive volcano erupted and collapsed inward, leaving behind a vast, enclosed ecosystem teeming with wildlife. Animals like rhinos, hippos, lion and elephants can be seen at the bottom of the crater. **Lemala Ngorongoro BLD**





November 7 After breakfast you will transfer to Lake Manyara Airstrip (app. 1.5 hours drive) for your scheduled flight (11:30 AM/12:15 PM) to Serengeti National Park. This park is home to the wildebeest migration. You will see lions and leopard in trees and sunbathing on the kopje.

November 8/9/10 For the next three day you will explore the Serengeti. The Serengeti, one of Africa's most iconic safari destinations, is a vast ecosystem teeming with wildlife and breathtaking landscapes. Known for the Great Migration, where over 1.5 million wildebeest, along with zebras and gazelles, traverse its plains in search of greener pastures. Lions, cheetahs, leopards, elephants, and countless other species thrive in its diverse habitats.

November 11 After breakfast today you will transfer to the airstrip for a scheduled flight to Arusha airport (10:45 AM/12:30 PM). You will then transfer to the Airport Planet Lodge near Kilimanjaro Airport to prepare for your flight home. **BL ONLY**
