Your tented camp is in central Serengeti making it easy to get around this very large park. Today you will have your first game drive in this famous park often featured in National Geographic.

Rwanda

Nov.13 Serengeti/Kigali/Volcanoes National Park

Today you have a scheduled flight from the Serengeti to Kigali, Rwanda (9:30AM - 11:30 AM). Upon arrival at Kigali International Airport, you will be met by our representative and transferred to Hotel des Milles Collines for lunch. After lunch you will visit the genocide memorial to learn about the Rwandan genocide, also known as the genocide against the Tutsi, which occurred from April 7 to July 19, 1994 during the Rwandan Civil War. Over a span of approximately 100 days, members of the Tutsi ethnic group, as well as some moderate Hutu and Twa, were systematically killed by Hutu militias. Afterwards you will drive to Virunga, Volcanoes National Park and arrive Bishop's House in the late afternoon. Dinner at the lodge. **Bishop's House BLD**

Nov. 14 After breakfast drive to the Volcanoes National Park main gate where you will be assigned a gorilla tracking group and guide. You will have a briefing by the trackers then drive to the trail head to begin your adventure.

Upon sighting the gorillas, you will spend a magical hour with them up close.

After the trek you will return to Bishop's House for lunch.

This afternoon you will visit Iby'iwacu Cultural Village.

Nov. 15 After breakfast today you will drive to the Volcanoes National Park main gate where you will be assigned a golden monkey tracking group and guide. You'll have a briefing by the trackers then drive to the trail head and begin your adventure.

Upon sighting the monkeys you'll spend a magical hour viewing them.

After the trek you will return to the Bishop's House for lunch.

You will then drive approximately three hours to Kigali.

Nov. 16 After breakfast at the hotel, you'll depart for a City Tour of Kigali. Founded in 1907 as a German settlement, Kigali did not become the capital until Rwanda's independence in 1962. On a city tour you will visit the Kandt Museum, tour old Kigali and the Craft Centers. The city has recently seen major economic development resulting in what it is today, a vibrant African city.

Later transfer to Kigali International Airport for your international departure flight.
