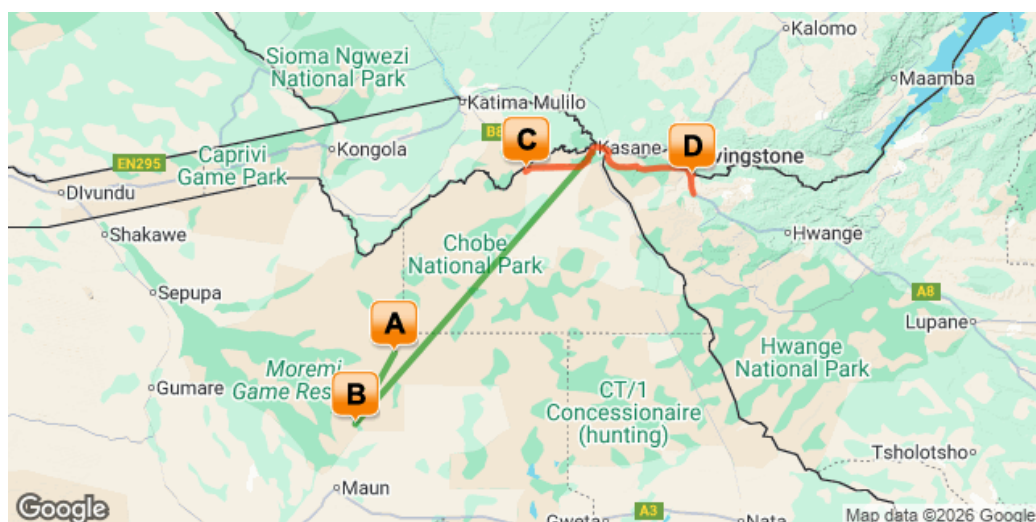

## Day 1-3

**Machaba Camp, Khwai Conservancy**



Located between the Chobe National Park and the Moremi Game Reserve in Botswana, the 200,000 hectare Khwai Conservancy is an enthralling place of wild landscapes and abundant wildlife. The plentiful Khwai River running through the park and dense Mopani forests in the interior provide the perfect home for numerous animals, and the incredible scenes of animals drinking from the river allow for superb photography opportunities. Visitors can look forward to seeing large elephant herds, and spotting lions, leopards and hyenas quite easily. Other species include wild dog, zebra, giraffe, wildebeest, buffalo, lions, cheetahs, leopard, hyenas, hippos, and kudu. Hiking, game drives, guided walks, spa treatments, and open-air camping are just some of the activities offered.

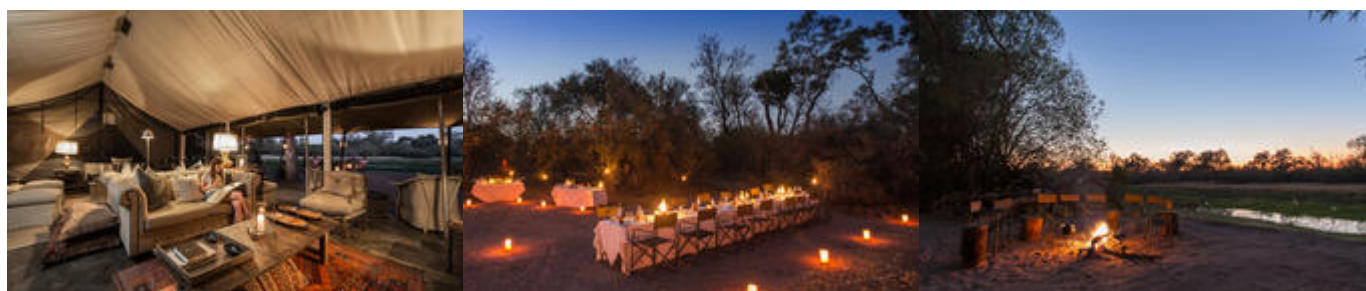

## Overnight: Machaba Camp

Machaba Camp is situated in the game rich Khwai area, on the Eastern tongue of the Okavango Delta bordering Moremi Game Reserve. The family friendly Machaba Camp is built in the classic 1950's style, with spacious luxury safari tents each with en-suite bathrooms and living areas, not forgetting the romantic outdoor showers. Machaba Camp's 8 luxury tents and 2 family tents are situated along the beautiful riverine tree line on the Khwai River, overlooking the famous Moremi Game Reserve. From these tented verandas one can watch the daily parade of animals coming down to drink at the river in front of camp. Activities include game drives, guided walks with armed guides, and mokoro safaris. Visits to the local community can be arranged on request.

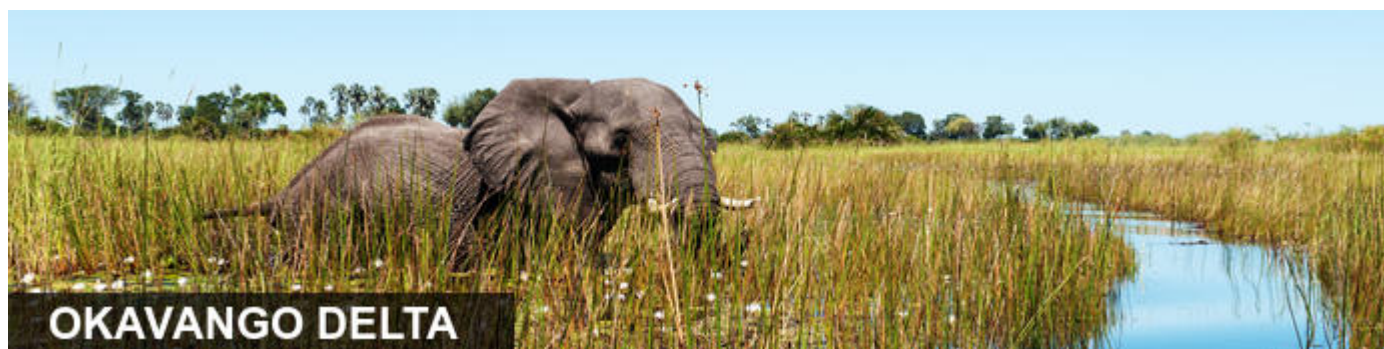

## Day 4-6

### Gomoti Plains Camp, Okavango Delta



Lying in the middle of the largest expanse of sand on earth the Okavango Delta is one of Africa's most amazing, sensitive and complex environments supporting a spectacle of wilderness and wildlife. Unique as one of the world's few inland deltas, the placid waters and lush indigenous forests offer a safe haven for innumerable bird and wildlife species. The Okavango Delta offers a number of activities for the visitor; game viewing, birding and fishing are all on offer. One can experience this magical world of islands and waterways from land, air and water. Highlights include the elusive Sitatunga antelope which has found refuge in this pristine wetland ecosystem, while birds such as the African fish eagle, Pel's fishing owl and many others provide a spectacular display.

After breakfast and morning activity (onward transfer flight time dependent) you will be transferred to the nearest airstrip for your flight to Khwai Airstrip for Machaba Camp

#### Overnight: Gomoti Plains Camp

The Gomoti Plains is located in a community run concession, on the edge of the Gomoti river system southeast of the Okavango Delta. The Gomoti tree is locally known as the water fig and grows alongside waterways in the Okavango delta. It's a smallish tree which sometimes grows no bigger than a bush. The area is known for its large concentrations of wildlife which thrive on the Gomoti plains and waterways. The Gomoti trees line the waterways and provide excellent cover for nesting water birds such as herons and storks. This exclusive area has been a well-kept secret for many years. The Gomoti region has been the local haunt of many of the older guides and Okavango dwellers who refer to it in nostalgic terms when they used to camp along this river system. This new camp has 10 luxury tents which include 2 luxury family tents and 8 luxury double tents, all with en-suite bathroom facilities.. In addition to day and night 4WD game drives, the camp offers water based activities such as mokoro excursions and motor boat trips.

## Day 7-8

### Ngoma Safari Lodge, Chobe River Front



The Chobe River forms the northern boundary of the Chobe National Park, renowned for its reliable and diverse game viewing. Safaris are conducted both by boat and on land. This section of the park is best known for its elephant and hippo populations but the waters attract all manner of game including large herds of buffalo and the lions that prey on them.

## Overnight: Ngoma Safari Lodge

Located in the Chobe Forest Reserve just 3km from the Chobe National Park, Ngoma Safari Lodge commands awe-inspiring views over the Chobe River and floodplain below.
